

Terms and Conditions and Participation Agreement for the Luckyday Scholarship

PLEASE READ AND INITIAL EACH LINE & SIGN AT BOTTOM OF FORM:

- Luckyday Scholarship amounts are calculated annually based upon your financial aid budget and other funding sources. You may receive the maximum Luckyday Scholarship amount as long as the estimated cost of attendance is not exceeded.
- Full-time enrollment of at least 12 hours each semester is required. Failure to maintain 12 or more hours each semester will result in the payback of the Luckyday Scholarship
- Eligibility for future years is conditional upon you maintaining at least a 2.50-4.00 cumulative grade point average (4.0 scale) on all course work attempted at The University of Mississippi and annual submittal of the Free Application of Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) prior to May 15 of each year.
- ____Luckyday Scholars will complete 10 hours of approved volunteer service hours each semester (8 semesters).
- ____Luckyday Scholars must attend class; unexcused class absences will result in the removal of the scholarship.
 - In addition to maintaining an overall 2.50-4.00 GPA at the end of each spring semester, first-time recipients must achieve a 1.5 or better GPA, for the fall semester, in order to retain their awards for the spring semester.
- Luckyday Scholars are required to reside in the Luckyday Residential College during their freshman year (or first two semesters). Luckyday Scholars will not be allowed to apply for commuter status with the Department of Student Housing.
 - Luckyday Scholars are required to enroll in a section of EDHE 105, First-Year Seminar, during the fall semester of the freshman year. Scholars will register for the course during their summer orientation session.
- Luckyday Sophomore Scholars will take a Sophomore Seminar Class (EDHE333) to engage in personal reflection on professional goals and to connect academic knowledge with the future work environment.
- Luckyday Juniors and Seniors are asked to participate in workshops and professional development opportunities designed to prepare for the transition from college to graduate school/professional school or their chosen profession.
- _____The Luckyday Scholarship will be immediately revoked if the Luckyday Scholar fails to demonstrate good behavior, citizenship, respect and appreciation while in the Luckyday Program and receiving the Luckyday Scholarship.
- _____Maximum eligibility is limited to eight consecutive regular semesters (excluding summers) or once a bachelor's degree is received (whichever comes first).
 - Renewal eligibility for subsequent years will be determined at the end of spring semester.
 - If you withdraw from the University within the 100% institutional refund period (the first 10 days of classes), any scholarship that has already credited to your bursar account must be repaid in full.
 - _This scholarship in combination with all other financial aid, and other resources may not exceed the student's estimated cost of attendance.
